

Brooksville Comprehensive Plan Committee

Minutes of October 11, 2018 Meeting

Members present: Denis Blodgett, John Gray, chairperson, Peter Van der Eb, Norm Alt, Donald Condon, Earl Clifford, Bud Fisher, Allen W. Kratz, Nancy Sanford, clerk. (Note: Nancy Sanford volunteered to be the Committee's clerk.)

Items discussed:

- 1) Clarification of purpose of this meeting and next steps were discussed. There had been some confusion as to whether or not representatives of other town committees/entities were to be invited to this meeting. Result of discussion was that Allen will work with Gayle Clifford on letter for John's review which will be sent to identified committees/entities asking specific questions. Requested return date will be mid-November 2018. Identified committees/entities: Library Board, Harbor Committee, Internet Committee, Planning Committee, Peninsula Ambulance, Healthy Peninsula, Solar, School, Fish, Gym, Historical Society, Blue Hill Heritage Trust, Maine Coast Heritage Trust, Road Commissioner (Mark Blake). John will contact the State of Maine DOT re thoughts they have about Brooksville roads.
- 2) Survey results: What and where should they be shared with the public?
 - a) Peter reports that the Internet Committee requested PDF of Survey results which he provided to them. These results did not include all of the comments that respondents included with their returned surveys. All committee members expressed agreement with Peter's action.
 - b) Committee members agreed that the above mentioned PDF of Survey results are appropriate for the Brooksville web page.

Allen raised the thought of a follow up letter to Survey participants as well as to townspeople in general. He again volunteered to work with Gayle Clifford on a follow up letter which will be put on the Town's web page and mailed to local addresses after John Gray's approval.

- 3) Peter confirmed that the Survey results will be put in the Town's vault.
- 4) Sheri Walsh, from the Hancock County Planning Commission, will be present at our next meeting on Thursday, October 18, 2018. We hope to learn from her when we might have a representative from her office to assist us given the recent departure of Anne Krieg.
- 5) Allen will look into free conference calling systems given some Committee members will be closing their Brooksville homes for the season in the near future. Nancy donated a Starfish device to the Town that Peter had for sale.
