#### Agenda:

##### Business:

1. Survey- John G. - he would like to see a survey sent to residents, similar to what was done in 2005/2006. That feedback would show what areas are most important to folks. This detailing could also help on any state funding which may become available.
2. What the 2018 plan will involve - Anne Kreig was in to discuss HCPC involvement, expectations and costs.
  - A. Template - State will provide samples of what other towns have included in their plans.
  - B. Cost for HCPC assistance - cost will be somewhere between \$10,000- \$30,000. That figure would depend on how much of project they manage, if they are just overseeing or if they do the actual work.
  - C. This may be done in stages, does not need to be done in one year. CPC would present a detailed list of expectations. This item would be presented to voters.
3. Informational Mtg. - Allan Kratz feels a meeting open to the public, mid summer would be good.
4. State involvement - State of Maine will not be as involved as they had been in 2005/2006.

##### Decisions -

HCPC Involvement - Anne will present a proposal of what they can do, what CPC could do, and Town's cost.

Survey - Plan is - Survey to be sent out first of July.

Public Informational Meeting - In August will schedule meeting, after surveys have gone out, are read & completed, and are hopefully being returned.
